

STATEMENT

ON THE REACH REGULATION EC 1907/2006


EBG electro GmbH, EBG eqs GmbH and EBG jung GmbH as producers of electrotechnical products are "downstream users" and manufacturers of articles according to REACH regulations. They do not produce substances or mixtures in the sense of this regulation, i.e. there is no intended release of substances from articles. Accordingly, there are no requirements for a registration obligation. However, parts and raw materials are purchased for the manufacture of our products.

In accordance with the duty to inform, arising from Article 33 of REACH Regulation 1907/2006, we want to point out that lead (CAS No. 7439-92-1 / EC No. 231-100-4) with a mass fraction > 0.1% may be contained in some of our products through purchased parts as a substance on the SVHC candidate list of the ECHA (European Chemicals Agency). This refers to lead as a copper alloy component (e.g. brass) or lead-containing components in purchased functional parts. Lead as an alloying element is used, for example, to improve machinability. In these parts, the lead content is firmly bonded and exposure is not to be expected. In this respect, no further information or special precautions are necessary for the safe use of our products. We work very closely with our suppliers to eliminate lead completely or to reduce the lead content to the legal requirement of less than 0.1 percent by weight.

To our knowledge, our products do not contain any other SVHC substances on the ECHA candidate list. Our suppliers are requested to inform us as soon as a product delivered to us contains a SVHC substance with a mass fraction > 0.1%. Should this be the case, we will inform our customers immediately.
